

MERIDIAN	MUSCLE	LOCATION	MOVEMENT
Central Vessel	Supraspinatus	Shoulder	Extension of shoulder i.e stretching forward with front leg.
Governing Vessel	Teres Major	Shoulder	Flexion of shoulder i.e. stretching of front leg back towards the back legs.
Stomach	Pectoral Muscle	Chest area between front legs	Controls flex and movement of the legs.
Spleen	Latissimus Dorsi	Mid-back down to shoulder	Assists the shoulder to pull the animal forward when moving.
Spleen	Trapezius muscle	Across base of neck shoulder blades	Allows animal to lift their front legs in order to step forward
Heart	Subscapularis	Shoulder	Braces the shoulder joint
Small Intestine	Quadriceps	Front portion of upper back leg (thigh)	Lifts back leg off the ground and moves it forward.
Bladder	Tibialis Anterior	Back leg. Front section of the hock (knee) joint	Bending the leg at the hock joint.
Kidney	Psoas	Deep within lower back	Rotation of the hip joint for forward movement.
Pericardium	Gluteal Muscles	Sit over the hip joint	Movement of the back legs from the hip joint.
Triple Heater	Teres Muscle	Deep in the shoulder joint	Movement of the shoulder joint
Triple Heater	Sartorius	Front section of upper thigh	Movement of back leg
Gall Bladder	Anterior Deltoid Muscle	Upper front leg	Forward movement of front leg.
Liver	Rhomboid Muscles	Top of the shoulder blades	Movement of shoulder blades.
Lung	Middle Deltoid Muscle	Upper front leg	Movement of front leg.
Large Intestine	Fascia Lata Muscle	Upper back leg	Extends and flexes the hip joint
